

RECIPE FOR FUN

Puzzling It Out

Intended for grown up assembly

Supplies Needed: jumbo popsicle/craft sticks, glue/glue stick, small picture (could be of your child's favorite animal or character or something else), clear packaging tape, scissors, box cutter, sharpie (optional)

Instructions

1. Find a picture and trim it to fit on the craft sticks.
2. Line up the craft sticks side-by-side and glue the picture onto them.
3. When the glue is dry, cover the picture and some of the craft stick on both sides of the picture with tape.
4. Flip it over and cut the craft sticks apart using the box cutter.

Optional: Write numerals, dots representing numbers, or the letters in your child's name on the craft sticks to introduce these concepts.
