


What Moves the Dead by T. Kingfisher is a quick, easy retelling of the *Fall of the House of Usher*. I loved the "witch-hare" addition as well as the fungal contagions. (Honestly, I love that fungi have become a staple of modern horror stories.) Outside of that I loved the casual and smooth introduction of neopronouns to describe the main character via their complex native language. (Who is a gender bent version of the male protagonist from the original story by Poe.) The only "negative" thing I would have to say about this story was that the buildup was long lasting for an ending that came just little too quickly for my liking. Overall, not a detractor because it left me hungry for more. (Also, I love that the author is a female writer from my home state of NC!)
