## Opening Fall 2025: Planetarium and Maker Lab at Headquarters



The main feature of the addition is the Planetarium Learning Center, which includes a 50-foot domed theater that seats 135 people and will show short features on space exploration, dinosaurs, and nature. Ticketed admission will be free.

Another highlight is a Foucault pendulum, the tool that proved that Earth spins on an axis rather than remaining stationary, as well as more exhibit, meeting, and education space.

## **The Kitty Black Perkins Maker Lab**

The Kitty Black Perkins Maker Lab recognizes Spartanburg-born-andraised fashion designer Louvenia "Kitty" Black Perkins. After graduating from Carver High School, she moved to California in pursuit of a career in fashion. She eventually became the Chief Designer of Fashions and Doll Concepts for Mattel's Barbie line, where she made history by creating the first Black Barbie doll. Kitty's legacy continues as the namesake of our expanded Maker Lab, which aims to inspire Spartanburg County residents to get creative with 3D printers, sewing machines, laser cutters, and more!



Construction on the Planetarium and Maker Lab began in April 2024 and is nearing completion! The 20,000 square-foot addition to the existing Headquarters Library will house both the 135seat Planetarium and the Kitty Black Perkins Maker Lab. It will also provide new meeting room space, offices, and activity rooms that further the library's commitment to lifelong learning, entertainment, and exploration. We look forward to a fall grand opening and this exciting new chapter made possible by both public funds and generous private donations.




