Millions of people across the country visit their libraries every week. What's the draw? Everything.

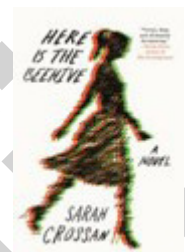
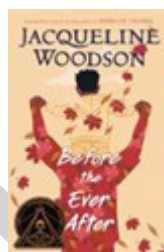
