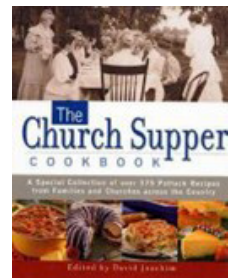
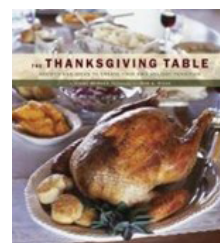
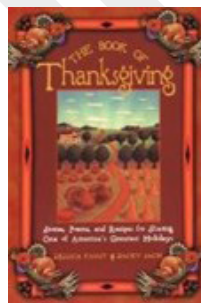

Dreamslinger by Graci Kim

Dreamslinger by Graci Kim is an entertaining and heartfelt first installment in a new middle-grade series. *Dreamslinger* follows fourteen-year-old Aria Loveridge as she grapples with her ability to enter and channel magic from a dream realm. Following the Great Outburst, a tragic event that killed hundreds of people including Aria's mom, Dreamslingers in her world are often repressed and isolated. After entering the first Dreamslinger trials, where teenage slingers from around the world come to learn how to use their powers, Aria is faced with the ultimate decision of holding onto the views she was raised with or accepting new ideas about how slingers can live in society.

Dreamslinger features creative worldbuilding bolstered by emotional depth and a thoughtful exploration of coming-of-age themes like identity, community, and familial dependence. An exciting read for young fantasy fans interested in character-driven stories, Asian inspired fantasy, and innovative magic systems.
