The Choice: Embrace the Possible by Edith Eva Eger

If you only read one book this year, this is the one. This book is as much a guide to healing as it is a memoir. Eger survived Auschwitz as a teenager, and that experience became the foundation for her work as a psychologist, helping others move through their own pain. Her big idea? You can't always control what happens to you, but you can control how you respond, and that's where real freedom starts. It's heavy in places (obviously), but also hopeful in a way you don't expect. Great pick if you're in the mood for something that'll stick with you long after you close the book.
